Description

The Design minor provides students with a foundation in graphic design, including design research and history, specialized software and tools, industry standards and professional ethics.

This minor enables students to learn different conceptual and technical approaches to designing compelling visual solutions. It enhances and complements students' respective majors by allowing them to use composition, color, contrast, illustration and typography to better communicate their work visually.

Admission Requirements

Admission to a minor is open to students declared in a bachelor's degree, the A.A.B. or A.A.S. degree or the A.T.S. degree (not Individualized Program major). Students declared only in the A.A. or A.S. degree or the A.T.S. degree in Individualized Program may not declare a minor. Students may not pursue a minor and a major in the same discipline.

To declare the Design minor, students must have a minimum 2.000 overall Kent State University GPA. No Kent State University GPA is required if the student is a first-semester freshman or transfer student admitted in good standing.
